The intern will work developing talking points, policy briefs, infographics, press releases and other material. Web design and social media advocacy experience is strongly encouraged. In the process, the intern will learn about the nexus between politics and policy having a front row seat during the 2020 elections.

Applicants should have a strong interest in current affairs and public policy. Our work is at the highest levels of Washington and on the campaign. Discretion and confidentiality is paramount.

The ideal applicant is well traveled with a curiosity for foreign policy and the role of America in the world. He or she is familiar with elections and the role Congress plays in shaping foreign policy.

Successful interns for PAKPAC could ultimately be rewarded next summer with placement on Capitol Hill and/or a front line political campaign.
